

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FOR EVENTS ORGANIZED BY APS FURIZON

Furizon is a Social Promotion Association, established in compliance with the provisions of the law, whose purpose is to give visibility to the Italian furry community, to organize themed events and meetings, to provide support and to coordinate with other subjects, including international ones, who pursue the same purpose. Furizon is a non-profit company but, as a legal entity, diligently fulfils its tax obligations. Each participating member, collaborator or director is personally liable for his or her civil and criminal liability.

The term 'PARTICIPATING MEMBERS' identifies those who, through their participation in the event, acquire the status of associates with respect to the Furizon association.

The term 'JUNIOR STAFF, or STAFF, or CONOPS) identifies the people who make themselves available to collaborate with the managing members, by whom they are coordinated.

The term 'MANAGING MEMBERS' (or ORGANIZERS, or SENIOR STAFF, or MAIN STAFF) identifies the members of Furizon's permanent staff, who are solely responsible for the optimal execution of the event but without any other burden. The activity of the directors is not paid by any remuneration, in fact, it constitutes an investment of time subtracted from their respective work activities and their free time.

Furizon welcomes all those who have an interest in the purposes of the association and the topics covered by it, however, the Trustees reserve the right to deny or revoke the participation of any individual at any time and for any reason. In the event of withdrawal of participation due to non-compliance with these rules of conduct, there will be no refund of any fees paid for participation in an event. All participants are required to comply with the rules of conduct for the entire duration of their stay in the areas affected by the events.

Any doubts or clarifications regarding these regulations must be sent in writing through the address info@furizon.net before the start of any event. The rules of the code of conduct will be enforced by Security personnel and will not be discussed during the events.

These regulations apply in general to all events organized by APS Furizon and remain valid without limits of time or scope of action. Each published version replaces the previous one in its entirety. Specific regulations may be issued for certain events and will be understood as extensions of this document.

Registration for any Furizon event presupposes full acceptance of these rules.

REGISTRATIONS & PAYMENTS

1. Reaching the age of majority is a necessary condition for participating in the events promoted by Furizon. The eighteenth year of age must be completed on the first day of the event. Participants are directly responsible for the declarations made and, in the event of false declarations, they will incur the provisions of the Civil Code that regulates the matter, as well as the possible expulsion from Furizon.
2. The payment of the fee or part of it presupposes the reading and acceptance of the regulations.
3. Each member, through the payment of the registration, delegates the administrators to independently dispose of the fee to make the event possible.
4. The fee must be paid in full within fourteen days of registration for the event. After fourteen days, the reservation will be cancelled. Participants who show up at the event without having paid the full fee (in the absence of prior agreements) will be charged the unpaid fee, increased by a late fee of 20 (twenty/00) euros. The Main Staff has the right to refuse admission if the available places are exhausted.
5. The Main Staff may decide to exclude certain participants from A PRIORI (ban) registrations. Payments from them will not be accepted and adequate explanations will be provided. The judgment of the directors will be final.
6. Registrations are non-refundable, but transferable. For the transfer, both parties must inform the staff from the "Contact" section of the www.furizon.net website and express their mutual desire to transfer the registration. The transfer is not valid until it has been approved by our registration staff in writing.

MEMBERSHIP CARD

1. Registration for a Furizon event requires the issuance of a card to formally acquire the status of Member of the Furizon Social Promotion Association, under the economic conditions established by the Board for the current financial year.
2. The fiscal year is understood to be from the first of October to the thirtieth of September of each calendar year. All cards issued during the year cease to be valid on the thirtieth of September. Cards can never be tacitly renewed.
3. All participants, starting from the first day of the event, must be in possession of a valid membership card. Failure to pay the membership fee or refusal of the membership card will prevent access to any event organized by Furizon.
4. The card, whether in electronic or physical format, constitutes legal proof of one's status as a Member and must bear the same personal data as a legally recognized identity document.
5. The card is strictly personal, non-transferable, non-transferable and non-refundable. Even in the event of the transfer of a ticket, the card remains valid for the year of issue in favour of the name shown on it.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Any action or behaviour that causes damage, annoyance or impediment to people, things or to the event itself and its staff is the direct responsibility of the person who carries it out. Such actions and behaviours may be punished with a simple verbal warning up to expulsion, and possibly with a temporary or permanent ban from the event at the discretion of the Directors based on the seriousness of the act. If such actions are criminally relevant, the staff and/or administrators who learn of their existence will report the fact to the competent authorities.

RULES OF PUBLIC DECENCY

1. It is not allowed to wear clothing and objects clearly related to any fetish.
2. Sexual acts that go beyond simple displays of affection are not permitted.
3. Indecent clothing that shows excessive nudity is not allowed.
4. It is not allowed to display adult items and materials in the public areas of the event. If you are in doubt about the appropriateness of a particular item of clothing, it is advisable to refer directly to the staff and/or administrators for clarification. Any decisions taken by the staff in this regard will be final and will become an integral part of the regulations.
5. It is not allowed to sleep in the event areas.
6. Gas cylinders or any other high-pressure vessel, regardless of their contents or size, are not allowed in any part of the areas relevant to organized events without the written permission of the security service.

7. The use of body paint must be authorized in advance by the Furizon security service, otherwise, or in case of non-authorization, if expressly prohibited.
8. Certain clothing or accessories that are normally prohibited may only be authorized as part of a costume if specific approval is granted by Furizon's security service.
9. All exclusive areas of Furizon events are always PG-13. Some events may be granted specific exemptions and deal with topics that are not suitable for all ages. Such events will be correctly reported to allow for any exceptions.

An integral part of these regulations is the appendix that refers to the rules of public decency issued by the Furizon Security Service.

SECURITY & BADGES

1. The location as well as the services provided during the event is accessible only to regularly registered participants.
2. Participants are identified by a personal badge, this badge is individual and cannot be transferred.
3. The badge must always be displayed and presented and given to any staff member who requests it.
4. Changes to the information on the badge are not permitted unless approved by the admin members.
5. In the event of an emergency, imminent or perceived danger, participants must allow access to their rooms to authorized personnel.

ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

1. Participants who are found in a state of disturbing drunkenness will be escorted to their room and measures may be taken.
2. It is strictly forbidden to consume drugs or other controlled substances, in any form. The use or possession of such substances will be immediately reported to the Authorities. Measures may be taken by the Directors.
3. Actions performed during an altered state will always be the responsibility of the perpetrator.

WEAPONS

1. Any type of weapon or potentially dangerous object must be presented to the administrators or security staff, and approved by them.
2. Weapons of particular risk may be modified in a non-destructive manner to make them safe or will eventually be taken over until the end of the event.
3. Firearms, bladed weapons, as well as other weapons that are subject to control or considered dangerous are not permitted.

PHOTOS & VIDEOS

1. The dissemination of audio/video material recorded during the event must be agreed with the staff, as well as with the individual participants present in the recording.
2. Administrators can use the multimedia material recorded during the event to promote future events (anonymously, i.e. without indicating the names of the participants present, but only recognizing the merit of the author). In accordance with the privacy provisions and the guidelines set out in the Furizon Association membership form, anyone who does not consent must make an explicit written request.

CONSENT TO THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Having received the information on the use of my personal data pursuant to Article 13 of Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 and Article 13 of EU Regulation No. 2016/679, I consent to their processing to the extent necessary for the pursuit of the statutory purposes. The Data Controller is the Association for Social Promotion "Furizon" in the person of its President in office with an office in the registered office of the same. The processing of data will be carried out both manually and automatically, in compliance with the provisions of the relevant legislation, by specially appointed persons. I also consent to the data regarding the registration being communicated to the entities with which the association collaborates and processed by them to the extent necessary for the fulfilment of obligations provided for by law and by the statutory rules. I authorize the publication, also pursuant to art. 10 c.c., as well as art. 96 and 97 of Law 633/1941, of the photographs and video recordings depicting my image taken by the Furizon Staff, without time limits, throughout the world, by any means and for any purpose, as long as they are not prejudicial to the decorum, honor, reputation, as well as the dignity of my person. I also consent to the storage of "sensitive" data pursuant to art. 4 paragraph 1 letter d), as well as Article 26 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 and Articles 9 and 10 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679, i.e. data "suitable for revealing racial and ethnic origin, religious, philosophical or other beliefs, political opinions, membership of parties, trade unions, associations or organizations of a religious, philosophical nature, political or trade union, as well as personal data suitable for revealing the state of health and sex life". The data will be kept for the period necessary to achieve the purposes for which they are collected. The provision of data is mandatory, otherwise it will be impossible to continue the relationship with the APS Furizon Association.
