ACTIVITY RULES

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all participants, please follow these rules during the *Motorfurs* event.

GENERAL RULES

1. The rules outlined in this document are an extension of the general *Furizon* regulations.
2. By attending the *Motorfurs* event, you agree to follow these rules.
3. The event organizers reserve the right to **remove any participant** who fails to follow these rules.
4. *Furizon* and the *Motorfurs* organizers **are not responsible** for any damage, loss, or injury that may occur.
5. Participants are responsible for their own vehicles and any associated costs.

REGISTRATION

1. Participation as an exhibitor is allowed only for holders of a *Furizon Zenith* ticket.
2. All vehicles must be registered in advance and approved by the activity organizers. All exhibitors must wait for confirmation before attending with their vehicle.
3. Unregistered vehicles will not be allowed in the expo area.

PARKING AND VEHICLE DISPLAY

1. Vehicles must be parked only in the area designated for the activity, in the space assigned by the organizers for each vehicle and must not obstruct the passage of other vehicles or access to emergency devices such as hydrants and emergency exits.
2. Vehicles may remain parked in the designated area only for the duration of the *Motorfurs* event.
3. No unauthorized modifications or repairs in the event area.
4. Any damage to the property of the conference center (for example, but not limited to: structures, walls, gates, flooring, etc.) caused by the driver's negligence,



incorrect parking maneuvers, or defects in the vehicle (e.g., oil leaks, parking system failures, etc.) will be fully charged to the responsible party.

PHOTO AND VIDEO

1. The general provisions of the *Furizon* regulations apply here as well. Each displayed vehicle may be photographed or recorded. If you do not want your license plate to be visible in photos, please bring a **license plate cover** or another method to conceal it.

SAFETY RULES

1. No burnouts, drifting, or loud revving. Keep noise levels reasonable.
2. Always follow staff instructions. Failure to comply may result in removal from the activity.
3. During *Motorfurs*, the vehicle owner must remain near the event area. You may be asked to move your vehicle for service or safety reasons.
4. No driving while wearing a fursuit head for safety reasons.
5. No competition or racing: this is a casual meetup for enthusiasts to show off their vehicles, take photos, and socialize!
6. Every driver, before starting, during the activity, and at the end, must always be capable of driving their vehicle in accordance with Italian regulations.
