

Furizon Zenith – Photo Booth

Regulations

1. Introduction

The Furizon Zenith Photo Booth aims to offer registered professional photographers a dedicated space to carry out their photoshoots. To ensure a safe and well-organised event, all participants are required to comply with these regulations.

2. Participation Requirements

- **Valid registration:** All participants must complete the registration process using the official form, meeting the stated deadlines.
- **Furizon ticket:** A valid ticket for the convention is required.
- **Maximum number of participants:** Up to 7 photographers will be admitted. (This is a provisional limit and may be adjusted depending on the opening hours of the dedicated area.)

3. Booking Details

- **Duration:** The photo booth can be booked in one-hour slots. It is possible to reserve multiple consecutive slots.
- **Booking priority:** Slots will be assigned on a "first come, first served" basis.
- **Props:** The photo booth will offer professional equipment and a selection of props, aiming to replicate a professional studio environment. Photographers and models are also welcome to use their own props.
- **Privacy:** Photographers who book a slot will have exclusive use of the room during their session and may independently decide who is allowed access.
- **Access and use of the room:** Use of the room is free of charge. However, access to the provided equipment and props requires a symbolic donation of €20.00 in support of the association.
- **Monitoring:** A.P.S. Furizon staff will be present during both handover and return of the room. For safety and control reasons, staff may enter the room at any time.
- **Responsibility:** The photographer holding the slot is responsible not only for their own conduct, but also for any breaches of A.P.S. Furizon rules, room regulations, or hotel policies by anyone present in the photo booth. In the event of infractions or damages, in addition to any applicable penalties, A.P.S. Furizon's security team and Main Staff may issue warnings or take other measures to safeguard the association's activities. The photographer is also responsible for the integrity of all equipment and materials provided within the booth for the entire duration of the reserved slot. The condition of all

items will be checked upon entry and exit. In case of damage, the photographer agrees to cooperate with the staff to assess the extent and compensate the cost of the damaged materials, based on their full replacement value.

4. Photographer Selection Process

Photographers will be admitted to use the photo booth until all available slots are filled.

5. Equipment and Props

Furizon Zenith will provide photographers with equipment to create a professional-quality studio environment. However, photographers must bring their own camera and all necessary accessories for its proper operation.

Equipment potentially provided by A.P.S. Furizon includes:

- RGB lights
- Backdrop
- Scene props
- Camera tripod
- Mobile table for equipment placement

6. Nudity and NSFW Content

The following are strictly prohibited:

- Any NSFW activity within the photo booth
- Soiling, damaging, or mishandling the provided equipment

7. Penalties

If a photographer or a subject is found violating the rules outlined in this document (either during the event or afterwards), the A.P.S. Furizon Main Staff may enforce the sanctions and measures outlined in the General Regulations of A.P.S. Furizon.

8. Changes and Communications

- The organisers reserve the right to amend these rules to ensure the safety and smooth running of the event.
- Only the official organising staff is authorised to issue valid communications about the event. Any information from other sources should be considered unreliable.
