



Furizon Polaris – Motorfurs Activity Rules

GENERAL RULES

- The rules outlined in this document are an extension of the general Furizon regulations.
- By attending the Motorfurs event, you agree to follow these rules.
- The event organizers reserve the right to remove any participant who fails to follow these rules.
- Furizon and the Motorfurs organizers are not responsible for any damage, loss, or injury that may occur.
- Participants are responsible for their own vehicles and any associated costs.

REGISTRATION

- Participation as an exhibitor is allowed only for holders of a Furizon Polaris ticket.
- All vehicles must be registered in advance and approved by the activity organizers. Exhibitors must wait for confirmation before attending with their vehicle.
- Unregistered vehicles will not be allowed in the expo area.

PARKING AND VEHICLE DISPLAY

- Vehicles must be parked only in the area designated for the activity and must not obstruct vehicles or emergency access.
- Vehicles may remain parked in the designated area only for the duration of the Motorfurs event.
- No unauthorized modifications or repairs are allowed in the event area.
- Any damage to the property of the conference center caused by negligence or vehicle defects will be fully charged to the responsible owner.

PHOTO AND VIDEO

- Each displayed vehicle may be photographed or recorded. If you do not want your license plate to be visible in photos, please bring a license plate cover or another method to conceal it.

SAFETY RULES

- No burnouts, drifting, or loud revving. Keep noise levels reasonable.
- Always follow staff instructions. Failure to comply may result in removal from the activity.
- During Motorfurs, the vehicle owner must remain near the event area and be available to move the vehicle if required.
- No driving while wearing a fursuit head.
- No competition or racing.
- Drivers must always comply with Italian regulations.
