



FURIZON “WEARS PAWDA” EVENT

Regolamento e Termini / *Rules and Regulations*

Introduction:

Furizon Wear Pawda by Furizon Polaris aims to offer participants an engaging and professional experience, allowing them to showcase their creativity and style on stage. To ensure a safe and well-organized event, all participants are required to comply with these regulations.

Participation Requirements:

- **Valid Registration:** All participants must complete the official registration process by the communicated deadline (30/05/2026).
- **Furizon Ticket:** A valid convention ticket is required to participate.
- **Participant Limit:** Participation is limited to a maximum of 50 people (*provisional limit, subject to change*).

Performance Details:

- **Duration:** Each performance must last approximately 1 minute. Slight overruns are acceptable, provided they do not exceed 20 seconds.
- **Costume:** A Fursuit is not mandatory; both partials and fullsuits may be used. If participating in Fursuit, it is mandatory to have an outfit to display. Borrowed fursuits are allowed with the approval of both parties and prior notice to the Experience Team.
- **Props:** Participants intending to use stage props must inform the staff in advance. Props must comply with Furizon safety standards and convention center regulations; dangerous or inappropriate items are prohibited. It is recommended to have objects verified by security in advance.
- **Safety:** Performances must ensure the safety of the public, photographers, and participants. In case of medical issues before the performance, the participant will not be allowed to take part, prioritizing their health.

Rules of Conduct:

- Participants must maintain a respectful and professional attitude toward others, the audience, and staff.
- Compliance with the Furizon Code of Conduct, safety regulations, public decency standards, and the event dress code is mandatory.
- Aggressive behavior or violations of the regulations will result in immediate disqualification, with potential further sanctions in serious cases.
- Offensive content, objects, or movements unsuitable for a general audience are strictly forbidden.
- Unrelated self-promotion and the expression of political, social, or personal opinions during the competition are not allowed.
- To encourage creativity, entirely copying others' outfits is prohibited.
- In case of disputes, the presenter and event staff have final authority.

Rehearsals and Preparation:

- **General Rehearsal:** Participants are invited to join the dress rehearsal 30 minutes before the panel is set to start.
- **Backstage Area:** A dedicated room for changing outfits will be available. The Fursuit Lounge will be available if the participant plans on wearing a fursuit. However, it is recommended to arrive at the event already wearing the outfit, especially for those with two or more outfits.

Procedure for Participants:

- Following the queue, each person enters the main stage after the previous one has exited the room.
- The walk lasts about one minute over a path of approximately 40 meters; keep this in mind and plan your pace.
- Along the path, there is a photography zone for posing. Afterward, follow the path back to the entry door to finish the walk.
- This is not a competition; the goal is to show oneself and showcase creativity.

Procedure for Public and Photographers:

- The audience will be seated on the perimeter.

- Photographers will have a dedicated space and can take photos throughout the entire walk.
- Attendees must not obstruct the path and should leave the panel silently if needed.

Modifications and Contacts:

- The organization reserves the right to modify the regulations for safety and correct execution of the panel.
