



Furizon Snack Exchange

REGULATION

1. Purpose

The event "Furizon Snack Exchange" aims to create a moment of gathering and cultural exchange through the sharing of sweet and savory drinks or snacks (hereinafter simply referred to as snacks or products) from around the world. The event is open to everyone who wishes to participate.

2. Participation

All registered members can participate in the Furizon Snack Exchange event. Participants are invited to bring products from their country to share with others. All participants are responsible for the products they bring. It is not mandatory to bring snacks to participate, although it is strongly encouraged and recommended.

3. Food Display Requirements

All products must be industrially packaged and sealed. Homemade products are not allowed. Each package must have a clear label indicating the ingredients and highlighting the presence of any allergens. Products that reflect the culinary tradition of the participant's country of origin are encouraged.

4. Prohibitions

Artisanal products that do not have a list of ingredients and allergen indications are expressly prohibited. It is strictly forbidden to bring products that contain or have been prepared with illegal or controlled substances. Alcoholic products must be consumed in moderation. Furizon security may remove unsuitable products from the table or suspend their consumption in the event of any excesses.

5. Food Safety

Participants must ensure that the products displayed are stored and transported in conditions that maintain their integrity and food safety until the moment of sharing.
